Welcome to the first Gaddus Scholars. The broad idea is stated in our website (www.gaddaprizet.ed.ac.uk/gaddus.php) and in our brochure. Here is instead some basic information regarding how the event will run.

- Gaddus Scholars 2012 consists of **3 workgroups** and runs over **3 days**;
- Each workgroup will have **2 resident leaders** who will follow progress and provide input and feedback over **6 lab sessions**;
- Each workgroup will also have **2 guest speakers** providing content through one-off **irregular memos sessions**;
- Lab sessions will allow participants to present their project proposals in depth and to make them part of the **workshop format**;
- The 3 workgroups will take active part in **3 plenary sessions** – these will consist of moderated round tables, the last of which will have the winners of the Edinburgh Gadda Prize as its special guests and will be open to the general public.
- Workgroups take place in the **Theatre (Workgroup 1)**, the **Library (Workgroup 2)** and in the **Hub (Workgroup 3)**.
- **Gaddus Special** and **Plenaries** take place in the **Theatre**.
- **Coffee breaks and lunches** take place in the **Court** – the Centre welcomes us to make use of their **garden**.
- All Gaddus Scholars are invited to a **Drinks Reception, David Hume Tower, Conference Room**, following the Inaugural Lecture on **Thursday 20.09, 5.15pm**, Lecture Theatre 5, Appleton Tower, 11 Crichton Street, Edinburgh EH8 9LE.
- **Gaddus Dinner** will be on **Friday 21.09, 8.45pm, Vittoria on the Bridge**, 19 George IV Bridge, Edinburgh EH1 1EN, 0131 225 1740.
- All Gaddus Scholars are invited to a small **Reception** in the **Traverse Theatre Atrium**, following the second night of the show and the Award Ceremony, on Saturday 22.09.
